Progress Area	What Parents Can Expect
Workbook Tasks	Students complete guided worksheets, reflections, and project pages.
Portfolio Evidence	Selected work becomes proof of learning and growth.



Monthly Report	Teachers may share a simple progress update showing skills improved and areas for support.
Certificate	Students who complete requirements may receive a Harvik Future-Ready certificate.

How Parents Can Support at Home

- Ask your child to explain one Harvik activity every week.
- Encourage your child to speak confidently at home.
- Appreciate effort, not only marks.
- Discuss safe and responsible use of technology.
- Sign parent reflection pages when requested by school.
