Module Sample: Communication & Public Speaking

This sample shows how a Harvik module is structured. The full teacher guide includes complete lesson scripts, activity material, printable worksheets, and assessment rubrics for partner schools.

Learning Objective Students introduce themselves confidently with name, interests, strengths, and one personal goal.	Session Duration 40-45 minutes, delivered as one weekly Harvik period.
Required Resources Class 6 workbook, speech planner page, timer, speaking cards, and peer appreciation slips.	Student Evidence About Me portfolio page and 45-second self-introduction record.

Sample Weekly Lesson Plan

Lesson Component	Teacher / Student Action
Warm-up	Teacher starts a name-confidence circle. Students say their name with a clear voice and positive posture.
Concept Build	Teacher explains that self-introduction is a life skill used in school, interviews, meetings, and public situations.
Activity	Students prepare a 30-45 second introduction using this structure: Name, class, interest, strength, goal.
Practice	Students speak in pairs first, then selected students present to the class. Peers give one positive appreciation.
Reflection	Students write: What did I do well? What can I improve next time?



Assessment Indicators

Voice Clarity Student speaks audibly and clearly.	Eye Contact Student looks at audience with confidence.
Structure Student includes name, interest, strength, and goal.	Listening Student respects and appreciates others while they speak.
